7-DAY GUIZHOU MODULE

(Add Beijing, Shanghai, Xi'an, or Chengdu to the tail ends of this trip for a complete 11-14-day trip)

Day 1:

Arrive in Guiyang 贵阳. Your Real China team will meet you at the arrival hall of the airport and will be your host while you are in Guizhou. Transfer to Kaili 凯里 for orientation and briefing by Real China tour leader. Enjoy a traditional fish hotpot welcome dinner.

Day 2:

Transfer to Wuyao village 乌尧村. Trek into the rural countryside to your local village and be greeted by villagers by way of a traditional Miao welcome ceremony. Housing assignments followed by group lunch. Participate in scavenger hunt activities to get familiar with the village. Group dinner. Finish the day with Miao history & culture learning 苗历史和文化学习.

Day 3:

Community service activity in the morning followed by farm work learning in the afternoon. Continue your studies on Miao history & culture.

Day 4:

Observe class in the local primary school

or Alternatively, experience tea picking activity and learn how to make tea. After lunch, meet the shaman 萨满祭司 of Wuyao village to learn more about local people's spiritual beliefs. Finish the evening once again with Miao history & culture learning.

Day 5:


Four hours' hike to find a waterfall in the national park (Round trip). Enjoy a BBQ lunch in the wilderness followed by an evening bon-fire party with some local villagers.

Day 6:

Bid farewell to your host and after breakfast, hike 3-3.5 hours to your bus. Drive 1 hour to Kaili and arrive in time for a late lunch. Visit Kaili museum, see stunning collection of minority costumes. Hotel check in and refresh before your farewell dinner.

Day 7:

Transfer from Kaili to Guiyang airport
